

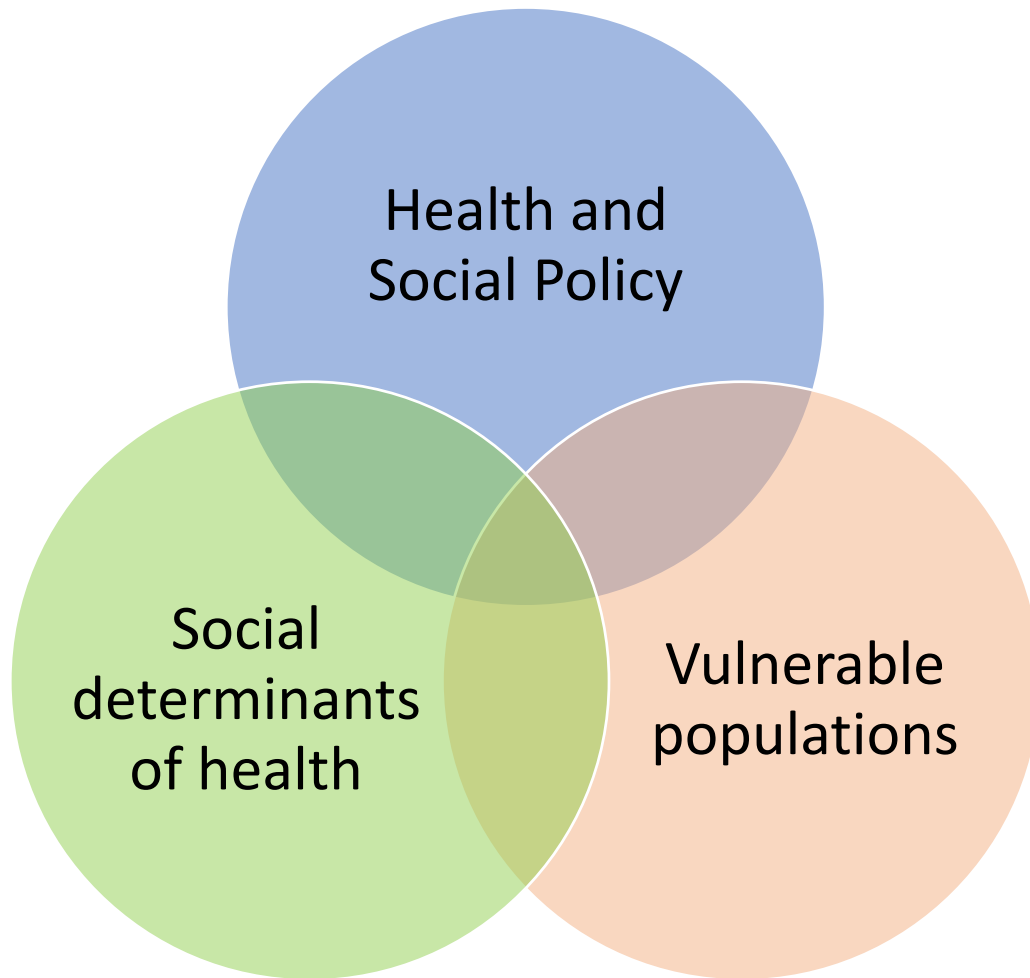

3

- ❑ Understanding factors contributing to health disparities and social inequalities
- ❑ How can we use policy to reduce these disparities and inequalities?
- ❑ Quantitative research
 - ❑ Mainly secondary data analyses (e.g., longitudinal data, large pooled cross-sectional data)

Research themes: Examples

❑ Food insecurity

- ❑ Affects ~14% of the US population
- ❑ I have done work trying to understand factors contributing to food insecurity
- ❑ What are some of the negative consequences of food insecurity for vulnerable families (mothers and children)?
- ❑ What interventions are effective in reducing food insecurity for these families?
- ❑ Proposal submitted trying to understand food insecurity among seniors who use food pantries

Research themes: Examples

5

- ❑ Welfare bans for drug felony convictions
 - ❑ In some US states, lifetime ban on welfare if convicted of drug felony
 - ❑ National Institutes of Health proposal under review that will look at the impact of this policy on
 - Health outcomes (ex-drug felons and their families)
 - Food insecurity
 - Crime recidivism

Other examples of current research projects

6

- ❑ Consequences of violence exposure on health
 - ❑ Poorer maternal health and greater risk of alcohol and drug abuse (published)
 - ❑ Maternal exposure to violence and unmet health care needs in children (under review)
- ❑ Racial disparities in access to back pain treatment (in progress)
 - ❑ White and Blacks are more likely to be prescribed opioids than Asians and Hispanic patients
